



The Security Protocol of participation in the Study Process of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering Study Year 2020/2021



Only perfectly healthy students who show no signs of infection are allowed to enter into the space of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering (FS). Persons with signs / symptoms of SARS-CoV-2 infection, persons who have been quarantined for the duration of the quarantine, or persons who have been ordered into isolation due to a positive test SARS-CoV-2 infection, should not come into the FS space, and are not allowed to be in contact with other students and staff for the duration of the isolation.



Upon entering into spaces of FS, hand disinfection is mandatory (disinfectants are installed at the entrance to the building and at the entrances to the Lecture Halls).



In all FS spaces (corridors, Lecture Halls, Laboratories, offices, etc.) it is mandatory to wear a protective mask at all times.



You shall enter / exit the FS rooms individually, using the safe distance of entering / exiting of at least 1.5 m.



Staying in the hallways is not allowed. During breaks, stay in the Lecture Hall / Laboratory, or go outside of the FS facilities.



In the FS Lecture Halls is a seating order with a guaranteed safety distance of 1.5 m (marked places). Physical presence is allowed only to those students for whom the presence for the FS lectures is defined and agreed with pedagogical associate in advance. Other students must monitor the performance remotely, using the MS Teams tool.



If you have any signs of illness, if you have been in contact with an infected person, if you have been ordered to quarantine, or if you belong to a vulnerable group, stay at home, report this to the Office for Study and Student Affairs, and monitor the pedagogical process remotely with the MS Teams tool, or agree with a pedagogical associate for a customised implementation of the pedagogical process.



If you develop signs / symptoms of SARS-CoV-2 infection, stay at home, call your doctor or Emergency Department and follow their instructions. In the case of a positive test, stay at home for the duration of the isolation and report it to the Office for Study and Student Affairs, and monitor the pedagogical process remotely with the MS Teams tool, or agree with a pedagogical associate for a customised implementation of the pedagogical process.



Follow the notifications on the website of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and the website of the University of Maribor regularly, and also check the electronic mailbox of your digital identity of the University of Maribor regularly (...@student.um.si).
